Since graduating from the Mailman School of Public Health, Michael has practiced health care law and is a partner at Lieber & Associates, LLC. Mr. Barnett served as New York State gubernatorial appointee to the New York State Hospital Review and Planning Council, served on the Council's Executive Committee and as chairman of the Project Review Committee.
