### **EHS Student Article Selected for Best of 2007 Publication**

An article on air pollution in Nairobi written by Environmental Health Sciences student Eleanne van Vliet and Patrick Kinney, ScD, associate professor of Environmental Health Sciences, has been published in *Environmental Research Letters'* (ERL) Best of 2007 issue, a mixture of perspectives and letters chosen by the Editorial Board, guest editors, and the publishing team.

Launched in 2006, ERL is now in its second year as a high impact open-access journal serving the whole environmental science community.
